Violinist **Alan Rawson** has served on the music faculties of Concordia College in Moorhead, Minnesota and the University of Idaho in Moscow, and has recently taken an extended leave from Minnesota State University Moorhead where he directed the University Orchestra and taught upper strings, and served as concertmaster of the Fargo-Moorhead Symphony for twenty years.

A native of Fargo, North Dakota, pianist **Sandy Rawson** has been an active professional accompanist throughout her life, performing with numerous soloists and ensembles. Completing her Bachelor of Music degree in piano performance at the University of Minnesota, she continued her studies at the Musik Akademie in Vienna.

Walter Schwede, violin

Violinist Walter Schwede began studying when he was eight years old and was selected concertmaster of the School Orchestra of America in 1965. After undergraduate work at the University of Michigan, four years with the U.S. Air Force ensemble Strolling Strings and completing his Masters at Catholic University of America, he began his Ph.D. at New York University where he also taught violin. Prior to joining the Seattle Symphony as Associate concertmaster in 1984, he taught at DePauw University, Belmont College, and was a member of the Nashville Symphony. He joined Western's music faculty in 1997. At Western he teaches violin and coordinates the string and chamber music programs. This past summer he was concertmaster for Seattle Opera's production of Wagner's *Ring Cycle*.
